Congratulations on exhibiting an outstanding photo this year for the photography project.

During the photography project judging, gold stickers were awarded on individual outstanding photos. Those selected with a gold sticker will have the **option** of participating in the calendar contest. By the deadline of September 15<sup>th</sup>, contestants will need to bring a **reprint** of their "gold sticker" photo to the 4-H office if they wish to participate. This should be a 4" by 6" photo or a "true digital". There will be a nominal **\$2 entry fee** to cover the cost of the photo scan, and you will need to fill out an **entry form**. All photos entered will receive recognition.

One horizontal, or two vertical photos will be selected for the space on the front cover of the calendar and 12 to 24 photos will be selected for the months (two vertical photos or one horizontal photo). Several photos will be on the calendar grid pages. A "Gold Sticker Honors" page will showcase some more of the photos.

We are so excited to have an opportunity to recognize outstanding individual photos that can be enjoyed throughout the year. Congratulations on your excellent work. We hope you enjoyed the 2021 Porter County Fair!
