

CITIZENSHIP WASHINGTON FOCUS June 25th-July 1st, 2022

4-H member must be at least 15 years of age and in 9th grade or higher by the first day of the trip. This one-time trip is an exciting experience for 4-H members to go to the nation's capital and learn more about the meaning of citizenship. Listening, learning, sharing, receiving, caring, and touring combine to provide a deeper respect and understanding for our American heritage and the principles, processes, and structures of the U.S. government. The trip to will be made by Purdue charter bus with a delegation of Indiana 4-H members and youth will stay at the Hyatt Regency in Bethesda, Maryland.

During the CWF program week, delegates will:

- Strengthen communication, leadership, and civic engagement skills on a national level
- Understand the importance of Youth Voice and the skills necessary to make change in your community, such as civil discourse and media literacy
- Exchange ideas, practice respect, and form friendships with other youth from diverse backgrounds
- Experience hands-on learning using the historical backdrop of our nation's capital city, Washington, DC, as your classroom
- Create a plan and work with your fellow delegates to develop the steps to carry out the plan upon your return home, to make a difference in your community.

Registration Cost

The cost of registration for the successful applicant(s) will be shared by the 4-Her and the Porter County 4-H Council. Registration cost for CWF is approximately \$1500 per delegate. The successful applicant will be asked to pay \$150 out-of-pocket, and the 4-H Council will pay the remainder. (If selected and unable to pay \$150, we will work with you to still allow the trip to be possible – so please apply!)

Through the following application process, at least two Porter County 4-H members will be selected to represent our county at this national 4-H event.

Once selected, the successful applicant(s) must submit their \$150 registration fee to the Extension Office. <u>Any individual who agrees to attend, and then backs out, will owe the 4-H Council the entire \$1500 registration cost.</u>

Transportation

The selected delegates will be responsible for their own transportation to central Indiana (in recent years the departure point has been the Boone County Fairgrounds in Lebanon) where they will join the rest of the Indiana delegation on a Purdue motorcoach that will transport the group to the greater Washington, DC area.

Application Process

Current Porter County 4-H members who are high school students and will be 15 years of age or older at time of the trip are eligible to apply. Previous participants of an *in-person* CWF trip are not eligible to reapply. Please apply by completing the following application and submitting it to the Extension Office no later than Tuesday, March 1st, 2022.
