



Porter County 4-H Rabbit ID Form

NOTE: 4-H Rabbit animals must be owned and in the personal possession of the 4-H exhibitor by the enrollment deadline of May 15th. The Rabbits must be under the same continuous care, responsibility and ownership until the close of the Porter County Fair. **Animals not entered on the Animal ID form by May 15th will not be allowed to be shown at this year's Porter County Fair.** Please list any and all rabbits you wish to have eligible for the fair. This includes a tattoo number, breed, color/variety, and sex of animal to be able to be shown at the Porter County Fair. Animals that are too young to tattoo, sex or identify color/variety as of May 15th should not be listed during the Animal ID process at this time and will not be enrolled, instead they must be a product of a buck and doe that are listed on the May 15th Animal ID Forms and also on the new Rabbit Meat/Market/Breeding entry form. The animals that fall into this category include meat pens, doe and litters, juniors and carcass rabbits; they will be listed on the June 25th stall form. **(As approved at the November 2022 meeting of the Porter County 4-H Council, paper forms will be the official Animal ID process for the Porter County 4-H Rabbit Project. No online fair entry will be required. Final declaration of animals/classes to be exhibited at the fair must be indicated on the "Rabbit Entry/Stall Form" which is mailed in June and due June 25th.)** (Animals born after this form is submitted must be products of bucks and does listed on this form to be eligible for the fair.)
